

Peninsula Private Hospital Redevelopment

Development Update # 4, 21st October 2011

After what must seem like months of planning and negotiating, the development at Peninsula Private will start in earnest on Monday 24th October.

All legislative requirements have been finalised and necessary permits have been obtained.

Because of significant delays with relevant authorities, the schedule for the building project has been reviewed and revised. It is now planned that the total project will be complete towards the middle of next year and not the earlier date that had previously been anticipated.

Scheduling of works will still take advantage of the seasonal downturn around the Christmas and New Year holidays especially for works in the operating suite, HDU/ICU and the surgical wing.

Components of the project will be undertaken concurrently with a view to completing all facets of the development at about the same time.

The first stages of the development will involve earthworks at the back of Jacaranda and Magnolia wings. As the new ward and admin blocks will be aligned very close with the boundary of the property, substantial excavation of land and building of large retaining walls will be one of the very first steps in the process.



Other ground works in this area will prepare the site for drainage and concrete slabs for the new buildings

Please note throughout the development, changes to the emergency exit points from the Jacaranda and Magnolia Wings. In the event of fire and evacuation, the fire warden will announce meeting places.

As construction gets underway, access to the various components of the construction site will be restricted to authorised individuals involved with the project. Peninsula Private employees may not access any part of the construction site (OH&S), although as different parts of the project are completed it is likely that tours for employees will be organised to showcase Peninsula's new development.

We appreciate your understanding and cooperation throughout the redevelopment.
